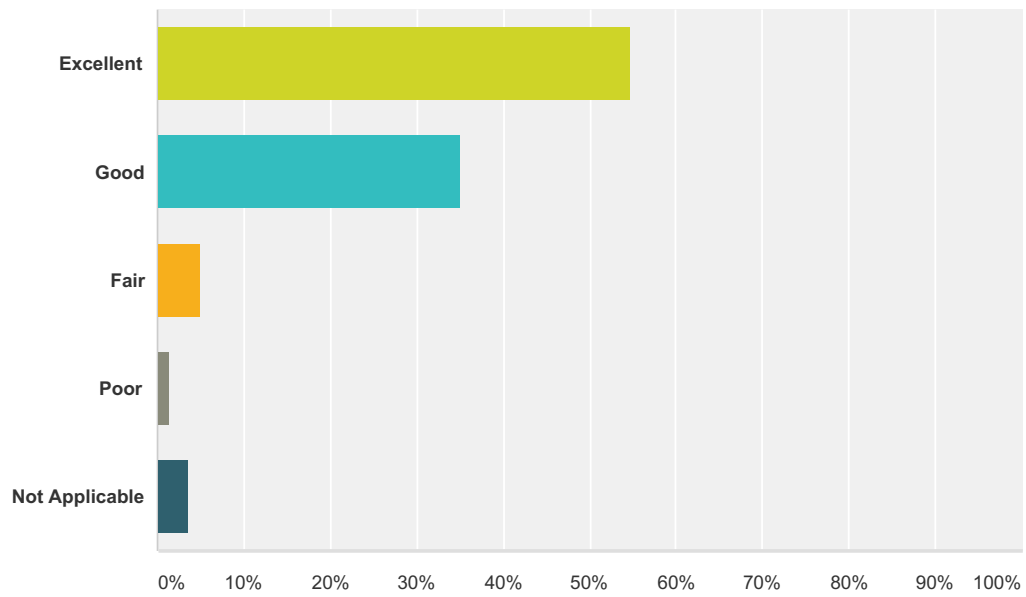

Q7 How was your experience with the conference mobile app?

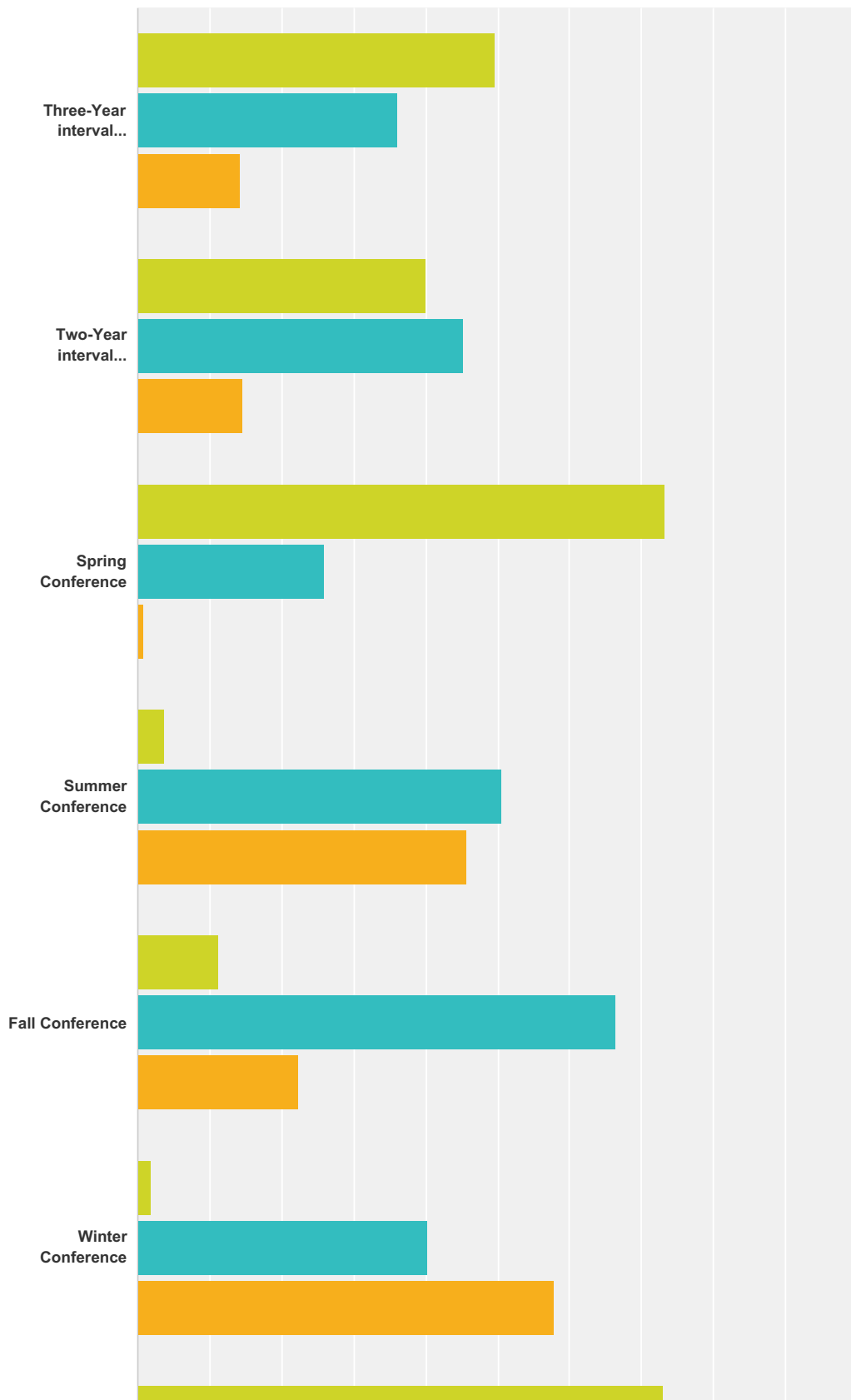

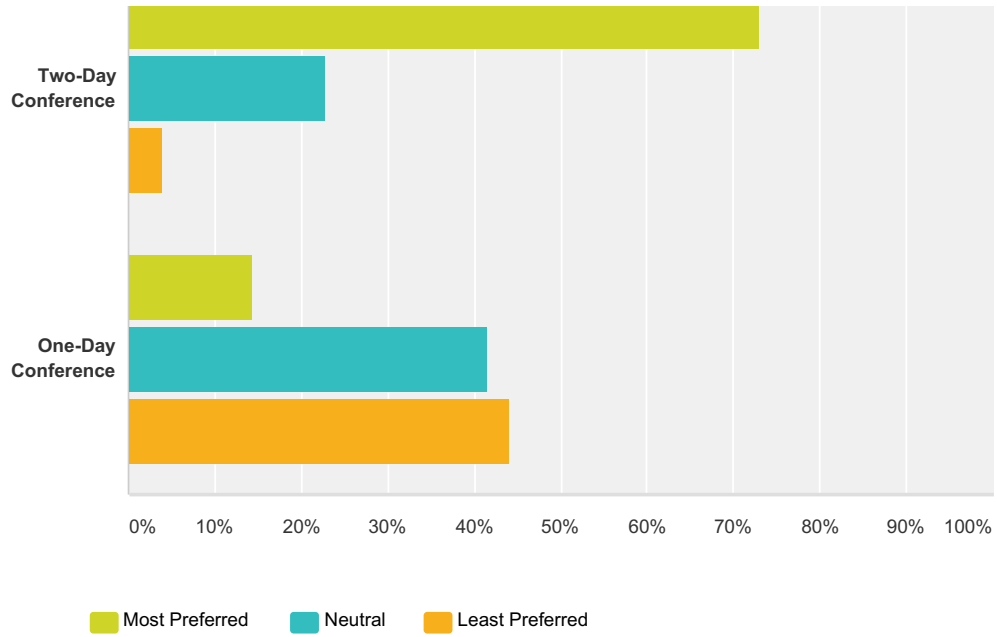

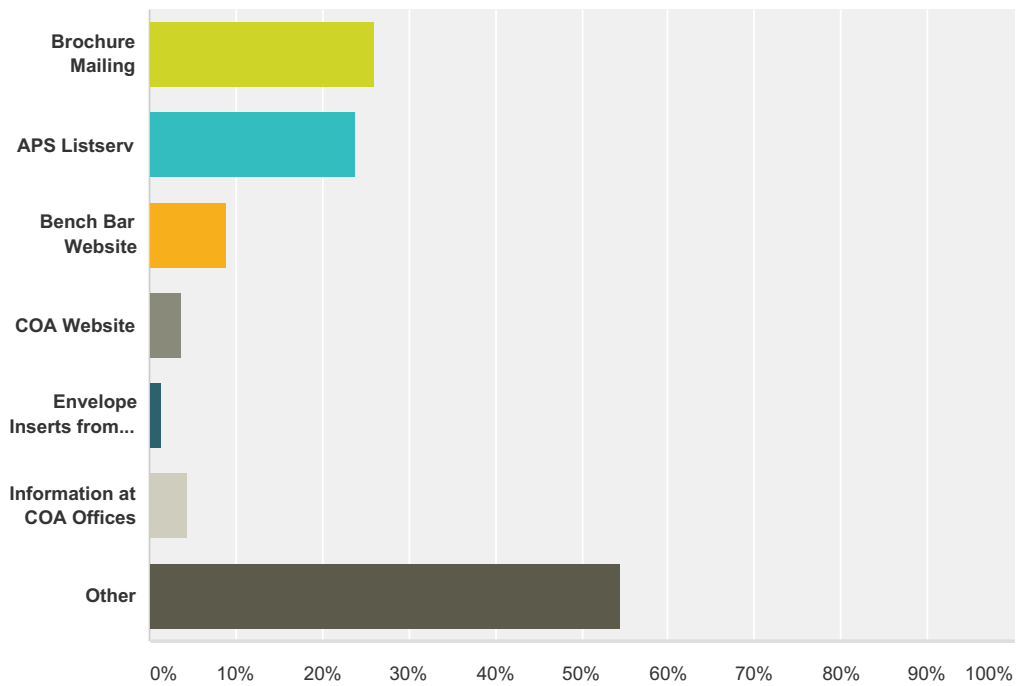

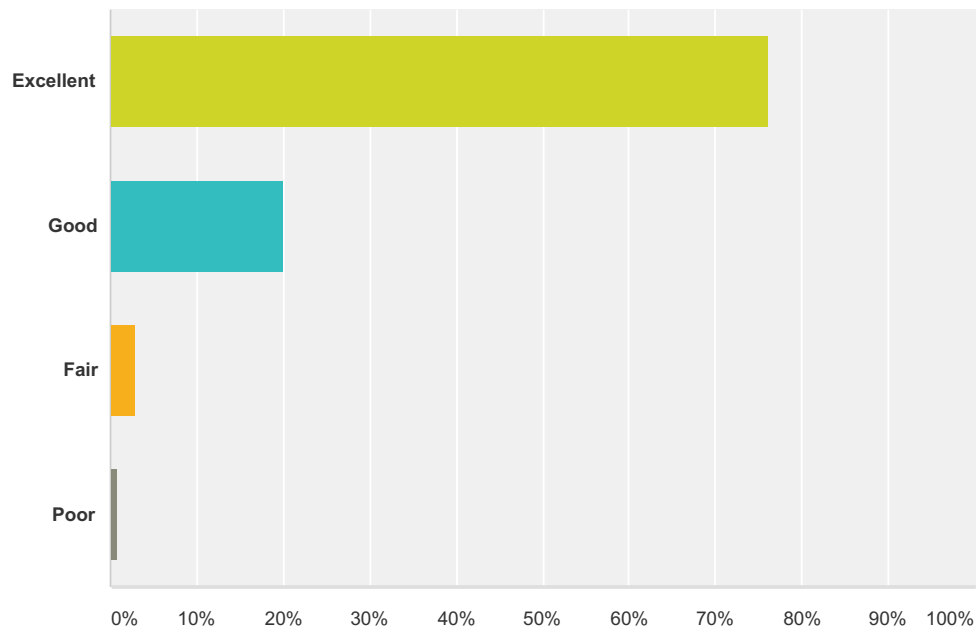

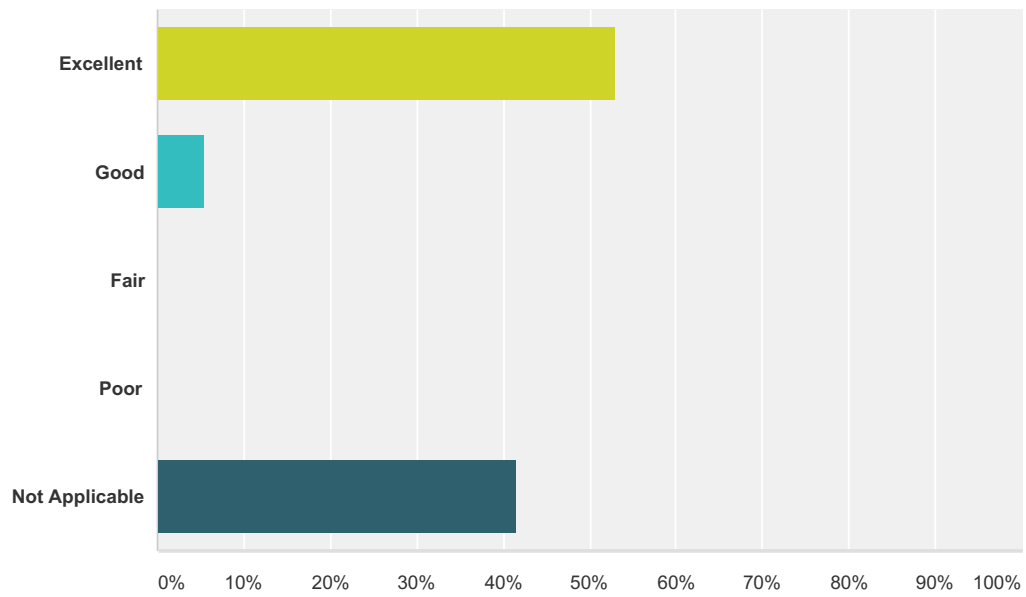
